According to NMC 2022 guidelines, Family Adoption Programme has been introduced as a part of the curriculum of Community Medicine. It intends to provide an experiential learning opportunity to students towards communitybased healthcare. This program preferably includes villages not covered under PHCs/RHTC. During the visit, we interacted with the families, and details were documented. Through this, we can tackle issues like health illiteracy, ignorance about communicable and non-communicable diseases, means to reach healthcare facilities, taking time off from their daily wage works and thus increasing the awareness about healthcare. The FAP is expected to sharpen communication skills which are the backbone of the profession; learning to be humane and empathize with the rural population by understanding their customs and limitations. 



All of this was possible with the unwavering support of our beloved principal Dr.P Shashikala Reddy who stood with us at all times. We are grateful for her support.




